## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

Section 75A (2) of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000 permits the Road Transport Authority to declare an organisation to be a Parking Authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002.

**Link Corporate Services Pty Ltd** has applied to the Road Transport Authority to be a Parking Authority for the following location:

Block 3 of Section 45 in the suburb of Turner

The disallowable instrument effects the declaration by the Road Transport Authority of **Link Corporate Services Pty Ltd** as a Parking Authority for the car park area identified allowing **Link Corporate Services Pty Ltd** to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
