Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, s 23 (Regular route services – power to determine maximum fares)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under section 23 of the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* the Minister may determine maximum fares, and ways of calculating maximum fares, payable by passengers on regular route services.

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2008-142 (Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares Determination 2008 (No 1)). This instrument is substantially the same as the former instrument, but includes a provision for residents of Oaks Estate to transfer from a Deane's Buslines service to an ACTION service free of charge.

The maximum fare amounts and other eligibility conditions for concessional travel remain unchanged.

This instrument commences 15 September 2008.
