Public Place Names (Forde) Determination 2008 (No 3)

Disallowable instrument DI2008 - 254

made under the

Public Place Names Act 1989— section 3 (Minister to determine names)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, published in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Section 46 of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that power given under an Act to make an instrument includes the power to amend or repeal the instrument.

Pursuant to Section 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

This instrument REVOKES DI2008-182 notified on 10 July 2008; and

DETERMINES the name of new roads in the Division of Forde as specified in the attached schedule and associated plan. The theme for Forde is *Community Service*.

Leslie Dwyer Street as notified in DI2008-182 has been revoked and Phyllis Frost Street extended. The road layout did not support two road names for this section of road. Leslie Dwyer will be commemorated in another location in Forde.

The number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years, and whether the names of women are well represented, have been considered as required by the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.

This instrument commemorates six women and seven men.
