Road Transport (General) (Vehicle Registration and Related Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2009–73

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 96 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* allows the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument has the effect of determining fees, payable in advance, for transactions relating to vehicle registration and related fees under the road transport legislation.

Vehicle registration and related fees have been increased by the Wage Price Index of 3.5%, rounded down to the nearest ten cents.

Heavy vehicle registration fees have not been increased through this instrument. Heavy vehicle fees and charges set by the National Transport Commission and the Commonwealth Government continue to be discussed nationally and will be revised once final agreement is reached.

There has been no increase in the road rescue fee and the short-term registration fee.

This determination is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
