Gas Safety (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 2)

Gas Safety Act 2000, s67 (Determination of fees, charges and other amounts)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Gas Safety Act 2000* is an Act about safety in relation to the use of gas, and for other purposes.

Section 67 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2009-149 that set fees for the 2009-10 financial year as new additional fees have been included for the 2009-10 financial year.

New fees have been set in relation to the inspection of residential and commercial gasfitting work and are based on a cost of work schedule developed in accordance with industry standards. These fees are consistent with inspection fees for plumbing and electrical.

The fees take effect on 1 September 2009

The determination under section 67 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
