Cultural Facilities Corporation (Governing Board) Appointment 2009 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2009 – 198

made under the Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997, Section 9
(Establishment of governing board) (see also Financial Management Act 1996,
Section 78 (5) (b) and Section 79)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997 establishes the Cultural Facilities Corporation.

Governing board members of the Cultural Facilities Corporation are appointed under Section 9 of the Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997 (see also Section 78 (5) (b) and Section 79 of the Financial Management Act 1996).

This appoints Glenys Roper as deputy chair and Pamille Berg and Crispin Hull as members of the governing board. The appointment begins the day after notification for a three year period.

The appointees are not Public Servants and this instrument makes an appointment to which the Legislation Act 2001, Division 19.3.3 applies. Accordingly, under the Legislation Act 2001, s.229, the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

These appointments have been approved by the Minister for the Arts, and the Standing Committee on Education, Training and Young People has been consulted in accordance with section 228 (consultation with appropriate Assembly committee) of the Legislation Act 2001.
