EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Race and Sports Bookmaking Act 2001* (the Act) governs the activities of bookmakers in the Australian Capital Territory.

In particular, subsection 90(1) of the Act provides that the Commission may, in writing, determine the minimum amount of security guarantees for licences, including sports bookmaking licences.

This determination sets the minimum amount of security guarantees for sports bookmaking licences at \$250,000.
