Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, s 23 (Regular route services – power to determine maximum fares)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under section 23 of the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* the Minister may determine maximum fares and ways of calculating maximum fares, payable by passengers on regular route services.

- This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2009-68 (Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Regular Route Services Maximum Fares Determination 2009 (No 2)). This instrument introduces free travel for the companion of passenger holding a Companion Card.

This change is being introduced following the launch of the ACT Companion Card in September 2009. The Companion Card is a national card, and as such, cards issued by other States and the Northern Territory are also recognised on ACTION Services

This instrument commences on 1 October 2009.
