EVIDENCE (CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1990

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 6, 1990

The Ordinance amends the Evidence (Closed Circuit Television) Ordinance to extend the period of time that Ordinance has effect from 23 July 1990 to 23 July 1991. The Ordinance was originally to operate for a period of 12 months to enable the Law Reform Commission to evaluate its operation. The Law Reform Commission will not be able to complete the evaluation by 23 July 1990 because there has not yet been a sufficient number of pleas of not guilty entered in cases in which the evidence of children could be taken under the Ordinance.

The Ordinance also amends the Reserved Laws (Administration) Ordinance to provide that the Attorney-General for the Commonwealth shall administer the Evidence (Closed Circuit Television) Ordinance.
