The Betting (Totalizator Agency) (Amendment) Ordinance 1987 amends the Betting (Totalizator Agency) Ordinance 1964 to deal with certain financial provisions and other minor amendments as a consequence of the proposed Australian Capital Territory Gaming and Liquor Authority Ordinance 1987.

The Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1987 amends the Liquor Ordinance 1975 to deal with minor amendments as a consequence of the Australian Capital Territory Gaming and Liquor Authority Ordinance 1987.

Details of the Betting (Totalizator Agency) (Amendment) Ordinance 1987 and the Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1987 are set out in Attachments A and B respectively.

LIQUOR (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1987

DETAILS OF ORDINANCE

Section 1 recites the short title of the Ordinance as the Liquor (Amendment) Ordinance 1987.

Section 2 provides that the Ordinance shall commence on a date fixed by the Minister for Territories by notice in the Gazette.

Section 3 recites the Principal Ordinance as the Liquor Ordinance 1975.

Section 4 amends sub-section 13(1) of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "the Board" and substituting "the Authority".

Section 5 amends sub-section 45(1) of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "the Board" and substituting "the Authority".

Section 6 amends sub-section 46(1) of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "the Board" and substituting "the Authority".

Section 7 amends section 455 of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "the Board" and substituting "the Authority".

Section 8 amends sub-section 59(1) by omitting "The Chairman" and substituting "the Senior Member".

Section 9 amends section 64 of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "the Board" and substituting "the Authority".

Section 10 amends section 75 of the Principal Ordinance by omitting "shall not absent himself" and substituting "shall not be absent" and by omitting "he" and substituting "the licensee".

Section 11 provides for further amendments to the Principal Ordinance by way of a Schedule. Part 1 of the Schedule provides for the substitution of "Authority" for "Board" in the provisions set out in that Part. Part 2 of the Schedule amends the Principal Ordinance by:

- (a) in sub-section 4(1)
 - (i) omitting the definition of "Authority" and substituting a definition that "Authority" means the Australian Capital Territory Gaming and Liquor Authority established by section 4 of the Authority Ordinance;
 - (ii) omitting the definition of "Chairman"; and
 - (iii) inserting the definitions of "senior member" and "the Authority Ordinance"; and
- (b) various other minor consequential amendments or amendments which reflect modern drafting practice.
