

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

HEALTH AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1986

Ordinance No. 80 of 1986

The Health Authority (Amendment) Ordinance 1986 (the Amending Ordinance) amends the Health Authority Ordinance 1985 (the Principal Ordinance) so that all the members of the Australian Capital Territory Health Authority (the Authority) and the two Boards (the Hospital Services Board and the Community Health Services Board) established by the Principal Ordinance shall be paid such remuneration as is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal.

Prior to the amendment only the General Manager of the Authority who is a member of the Authority was paid such remuneration as is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal. The Authority and the two Boards were prescribed authorities for the purpose of the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 so that the members of the Authority (except for the General Manager) and the members of the two Boards were paid in accordance with rates set out in that Ordinance.

The Amending Ordinance repeals the three separate sections respectively providing for the remuneration of the members of the Authority (section 13), the General Manager (section 22) and the members of the two Boards (section 34) and replaces them with a new section 78A which provides that the members of the Authority (which includes the General Manager) and the members of each of the two Boards shall be paid such remuneration as is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal.
