MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO.2) 1985

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 54 OF 1985

The Motor Omnibus Services (Amendment) Ordinance (No.2) 1985 amends sub-section 4BA(4) of the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955 to limit the use of a daily ticket, purchased to permit travel on a motor omnibus service without payment of a fare, to a journey other than during the peak period (which is the time prior to 9.00am on a weekday which is not a holiday). The amendment, follows the reduction in price of adult and concession daily tickets, which is intended to make their purchase and use more attractive.

Sections 1 and 2 deal with interpretation.

Section 3 amends section 2 of the principal Ordinance by inserting definitions of "holiday" and "peak-period journey" to accord with the use of those expressions in section 4 of the Ordinance.

Section 4 amends sub-section 4BA(4) of the principal Ordinance in the manner outlined above.
