REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1984

ORDINANCE NO 19 OF 1984

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Remuneration Ordinance 1976 prescribes sitting fees and the rate of travelling allowance payable to members of certain statutory authorities in the Territory not covered specifically in the determination of the Remuneration Tribunal. It has been the practice to set these rates at the levels determined by the Remuneration Tribunal for part-time office-holders. The Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1984 amends the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 to bring the rate of remuneration and travelling allowance prescribed into line with that decided by the Remuneration Tribunal in its 1983 determination. The increased rates have effect from 6 October 1983 which also accords with the Tribunal's determination.

Details of the amending Ordinance are set out below:

Section 1 cites the short title of the Ordinance as the Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1984.

Section 2 fixes the date of commencement of the Ordinance as 6 October 1983.

Section 3 amends the fees and allowances prescribed in section 3 of the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 by inserting the new rates fixed by the Remuneration Tribunal in its 1983 determination.
