HEALTH COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO.2) 1984

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 42 of 1984

---

The Health Commission (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1984 (the amending Ordinance) amends the Health Commission 1975 (the principal Ordinance) by permitting the determination of terms and conditions for persons appointed as the Commissioners of the Capital Territory Health Commission.

Sections 1 and 2 provides for the citation of the Short Title and the principal Ordinance.

Section 3 amends section 10 of the principal Ordinance by providing that the Governor General may determine the terms and conditions upon which the Commissioners will hold office.

Section 4 amends section 14 of the principal Ordinance by qualifying the Minister's right to grant leave of absence to circumstances within the terms and conditions of the appointment.

Proposed section 5 provides as a transitional provision that the Minister may, subject to the principal Ordinance, by instrument in writing, determine the terms and conditions of employment of the current Commissioners. No such provision is presently included in the Ordinance.
