EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The National Exhibition Centre Trust (Amendment) Ordinance 1983 (the proposed Ordinance) amends the National Exhibition Centre Trust Ordinance 1976 (the existing Ordinance) to allow for the appointment to the National Exhibition Centre Trust (the Trust) of a member of the Australian Capital Territory House of Assembly (the Assembly) nominated by the Assembly.

Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the proposed Ordinance deal with interpretation.

Section 4 of the proposed Ordinance amends section 8 of the existing Ordinance to provide for the appointment to the Trust of a member of the Assembly nominated by the Assembly from amongst its members. Provision is made for the nominated member to hold office on the Trust until the first meeting of the Assembly after the Assembly elections next following his appointment to the Trust, and for the Assembly nominee to cease to hold office if he ceases to be an Assembly member.

Section 5 of the proposed Ordinance amends section 16 of the existing Ordinance to provide that only a person nominated by the Assembly from amongst its members may be appointed to act in place of the Assembly nominee on the Trust.
