HEALTH COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1983

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Ordinance No. 65 of 1983

---

The Health Commission (Amendment) Ordinance 1983 (the amending Ordinance) amends the Health Commission Ordinance 1975 (the principal Ordinance) to alter the method of determining remuneration for Chairmen of the Staff Appeals Boards and the Promotions Appeals Boards established under the existing Ordinance.

Sections 1 and 2 of the amending Ordinance provide for procedural matters.

Section 3 amends section 45 of the principal Ordinance by deleting sub-section (3) which provides for remuneration of the Chairmen of the Promotions Appeals Boards to be determined by the Minister and inserting a new sub-section which provides that the Chairmen shall be paid such remuneration as is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal and in the absence of such determination, remuneration as is prescribed.

Section 4 makes a similar amendment to existing section 51(3) which deals with remuneration of the Chairmen of the Staff Appeals Boards.

Section 5 provides for the Capital Territory Health Commission to determine the terms and conditions (including remuneration) of members of committees appointed pursuant to existing section 93 to assist the Commission in relation to a matter of the Commission's responsibility.

The consequential repeal of Regulation 9 of the Health Commission Regulations will be effected contemporaneously with the making of the proposed Ordinance.
