DOG CONTROL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1982

No. 65 of 1982

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Dog Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1982 (the amending Ordinance) amends the Dog Control Ordinance 1975 (the Principal Ordinance) to increase the fees for registration of dogs other than those which are sterile and the fees for poundage of dogs.

Sections 1 and 2 of the amending Ordinance are interpretation provisions.

Section 3 of the amending Ordinance amends section 9 (3) (b) of the Principal Ordinance to increase the fee for registration or renewal of registration of an unsterilised dog from \$8 to \$9.

Section 4 of the amending Ordinance amends section 30 (2) of the Principal Ordinance to increase the fees for the poundage of a dog as follows:

- . under 24 hours - from \$15 to \$18
- . between 24 and 48 hours - from \$23 to \$28
- . over 48 hours - from \$31 to \$37
