SCAFFOLDING AND LIFTS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1982

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

NO. 68 OF 1982

The Scaffolding and Lifts (Amendment) Ordinance (No.2) 1982 amends the Scaffolding and Lifts Ordinance 1957 (the Principal Ordinance) to vary some of the fees payable under the Principal Ordinance.

Section 1 of the Ordinance deals with interpretation.

Section 2(a) of the Ordinance amends Item 11 of Part II of the Schedule of the Principal Ordinance to provide for an increase in fees for persons giving notice as required under section 6 (1) of the Scaffolding and Lifts Act 1912 (N.S.W.) in its application to the Territory of their intention to carry out building work (not being building work in relation to a single private dwelling house) in which a crane, hoist, plant or scaffolding is to be used, as follows:

- (i) where the cost of the work exceeds \$5,000 but is less than \$100,000 - \$5 for every \$1,000 or part thereof of the cost. The previous provision provided that where the cost of the work exceeded \$2,000 but was less than \$100,000 - \$4 for every \$1,000 or part thereof of the cost; and
- (ii) where the cost of the work exceeds \$100,000 - \$500 and \$1 for every \$1,000 or part thereof by which the cost exceeds \$100,000. The previous provision provided that where the cost of the work exceeded \$100,000 - \$400 and \$2 for every \$4,000 or part thereof of the cost.

Section 2(b) of the Ordinance provides for an increase from \$1 to \$2 for the fee to be paid by an applicant for a learner's permit for either a power crane or a power hoist or to act as a rigger, dogman, scaffolder or crane chaser as prescribed in paragraph (a) in the third column of Item 24A in Part II of the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance.
