REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES

(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO. 2) 1982

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1982 amends the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Ordinance 1963 (the Principal Ordinance) by increasing the fees for the registration of a change of name, the issue of a certificate relating to intended marriages outside Australia, a search of the Register of Foreign Marriage Notices and the issue of a copy or extract, a search in the Register and the issue of a copy extract or notification of result and priority service.

Sections 1 and 2 of the Ordinance deal with interpretation provisions.

Section 3 of the Ordinance amends section 22(1) of the Principal Ordinance to increase the fee for the registration of a change of name from \$3 to \$5.

Sections 4(a) and 4(b) of the Ordinance amend respectively sections 56(4) and 56(7) of the Principal Ordinance to increase the fee for the issue of a certificate relating to an intended marriage outside Australia from \$4 to \$8, and to increase the fee for a search of the Register of Foreign Marriage Notices and the inspection and issue of a copy or extract from a notice from \$3 to \$5.

Sections 5(a), 5(b), 5(c) and 5(d) of the Ordinance amend the Fifth Schedule to the existing Ordinance to increase the fees for a search in a register and the issue of a copy of an entry, a search in a register and the issue of an extract from an entry, a search in a register and the issue of a notification of the result of a search and the priority fee for same day issue of a copy of an entry or an extract from an entry from \$5, \$3, \$3, and \$3 to \$8, \$5, \$5 and \$5 respectively.
