EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

HEALTH PROFESSIONS BOARDS (PROCEDURES)
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1982

85 of 1982

The Health Professions Boards (Procedures) (Amendment) Ordinance 1982 provides that where a Board gives a direction prohibiting or restricting:

- the publication of evidence given before the Board or of matters contained in documents lodged with the Board, and
- the disclosure to some or all of the parties to an inquiry before a Board of evidence given before the Board or of the contents of a document lodged with the Board in relation to the inquiry,

a person shall not fail to comply with the direction. The penalty for failure to comply with the direction is \$1,000 or imprisonment for 6 months.
