PAROLE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO. 3) 1982

91 of 1982

The Parole (Amendment) Ordinance 1982 which was approved by the Governor-General in Council on 15 February 1982, provided in section 3 that the Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister for the Capital Territory by notice in the Gazette. No date has been so fixed. On 13 October 1982 the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1982 was approved by the Governor-General in Council. This Ordinance was so drafted as to come into operation on the date of its gazettal, which took place on 20 October 1982. As a result, the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1982 came into operation before the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance 1982. The proposed Ordinance seeks to regularize this situation by amending the commencement provision in the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance 1982 so that it shall be deemed to have come into operation on 19 October 1982, the day before the commencement of the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 2) 1982.

Details of the proposed Ordinance are set out below: -

- Clause 1 provides for the short title and citation.
- Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the Ordinance.
- Clause 3 repeals the commencement provision of the Parole (Amendment) Ordinance 1981 and substitutes a fresh commencement provision.
