AMENDMENT OF THE PLANT DISEASES ORDINANCE 1934

No.7 of 1981

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Plant Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance 1981 allows prompt authorisation of the use of new preparations as they become available for the control of plant pests.

Sections 1 and 2 introduce the Ordinance.

Section 3 repeals sections 3 and 4 of the Principal Ordinance which have no further relevance.

Section 4 adds to the definition section of the Principal Ordinance, the concept of an 'approved insecticide' as declared by the Minister from time to time.

Section 5 adds a new section to the Principal Ordinance providing for notification in the Gazette of approved insecticides as they are declared.

Section 6 in conjunction with section 3 repeals the Schedule to the Principal Ordinance which has no further relevance.
