AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR TRAFFIC ORDINANCE 1936

1981 No.8

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The purpose of the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No.2) 1981 is to restore to the definition of 'drug' in the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 the substances unintentionally excluded in consequence of the promulgation of the Poisons and Narcotic Drugs Ordinance 1978 and the 1978 amendments to the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933 and the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance 1957.

Section 1 introduces the Ordinance.

Paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 2 amend the citation of the Ordinances mentioned in the definition of 'drug' to accord with section 41 of the Interpretation Ordinance 1967 which provides for a brief citation of amended Ordinances.

Paragraph (c) of section 2 deletes paragraph (c) of the definition which referred to a no longer extant Schedule to the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933 and inserts a new provision which includes all the substances unintentionally removed from the definition.
