EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

POISONS AND NARCOTICS DRUGS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1981

POISONS AND DANGEROUS DRUGS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1981

ISSUED BY AUTHORITY OF THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEALTH

The 2 amending Ordinances will apply the system of regulation imposed by the Poisons and Narcotic Drugs Ordinance 1978 on controlled substances and by the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance 1933 on restricted substances to the substances to which the Convention on Psychotropic Substances applies which were not controlled or restricted substances as the case may be for the purposes of the respective Ordinances.

In addition the Poisons and Narcotic Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance 1981 makes it an offence to manufacture a substance to which the Convention applies without having applied for and been granted a licence by the Chairman of the Capital Territory Health Commission.
