MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO.2)1981

ORDINANCE NO. 25

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Motor Omnibus Services (Amendment) Ordinance (No.2) 1981 amends the Motor Omnibus Services Ordinance 1955 (the Principal Ordinance) to provide that the Minister may make arrangements for the sale of weekly tickets to children, school students, tertiary students, immigrant students, student nurses, pensioners and unemployed persons. It also extends arrangements for the sale of quarterly tickets to tertiary students, immigrant students, student nurses and unemployed persons.

Sections 1 and 2 deal with interpretation provisions.

Section 3 amends section 2 of the Principal Ordinance to include definitions of "immigrant student", "student nurse", "unemployed person", and "tertiary student".

Section 4 inserts a new section 4BB in the Principal Ordinance to provide for a weekly ticket to be made available to children, school students, tertiary students, immigrant students, student nurses, pensioners and unemployed persons at a rate to be prescribed.

Section 5 amends section 4CB of the Principal Ordinance to expand the classes of persons for whom the Minister may make arrangements for the sale of quarterly tickets to include tertiary students, immigrant students, student nurses, and unemployed persons in addition to the present classes of persons, namely, children, school students and pensioners.

Section 6 effects a consequential amendment to section 4CC of the Principal Ordinance.
