MOTOR TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO.3) 1981

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No.3) 1981 amends the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 (the Principal Ordinance) to provide eligibility criteria for applicants for bus driving licences. These criteria are the same as those applying to applicants for taxi, private hire care, and licensed goods motor vehicle licences.

Sections 1 and 2 introduce the Ordinance.

Section 3(a) extends section 10(5) of the Principal Ordinance to enable the Registrar of Motor Vehicles to refuse a bus driver's licence to a person who does not produce a certificate of good character.

Section 3(b) extends section 10(5A) of the Principal Ordinance to enable the Registrar to refuse a bus driver's licence unless the applicant produces evidence that he is a fit and proper person and able to speak, read and write the English language.
