RATES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1981

ORDINANCE NO. 35

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Rates (Amendment) Ordinance 1981 enables officers authorized by the Secretary of the Department of the Capital Territory to issue certificates in respect of rateable land stating that rates have not been paid. In any proceedings a certificate will be evidence that specified rates have not been paid in respect of a particular parcel of land.

Sections 1 and 2 of the Ordinance deal with interpretation provisions.

Section 3 of the Ordinance repeals section 27 of the Rates Ordinance 1926 (the Principal Ordinance) which provides for the Secretary to issue a certificate stating that rates have not been paid.

Section 4 of the Ordinance amends section 35 of the Principal Ordinance to authorize officers to issue a certificate stating that rates have not been paid.
