HOLIDAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1980 No. 1

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1980 permanently fixes a date as the Canberra Day public holiday so as to permit organisations interested in forward planning to be aware of the precise date on which this holiday will fall.

Sections 1 and 2 of the proposed Holidays (Amendment) Ordinance 1980 deal with commencement and interpretation provisions.

Section 3 of that Ordinance fixes the third Monday in March as the Canberra Day public holiday.
