PROTECTION OF LANDS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1980

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Protection of Lands (Amendment) Ordinance 1980 amends the Protection of Lands Ordinance 1937 by increasing the fee payable for a permit to take from Commonwealth lands any stone, shell, sand, gravel, clay or earth.

The previous and new fees are:

The previous fee was set in 1959 and the increase is intended merely to meet increased administration costs associated with the issue and regulation of permits.

Royalty charges are not a component of the fee. The permits are mostly limited to small extraction areas becoming available as a result of urban development. In large extraction areas only, the Minister grants a lease of the site and the rent reflects the specific use of that land.
