AMENDMENT OF REMUNERATION ORDINANCE 1976

Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1980

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

No. 12 of 1980

The Remuneration Ordinance 1976 prescribes the rate of remuneration which is payable to a part-time member of certain prescribed ACT statutory bodies in respect of his attendance at meetings, engagement on business and overnight absences from his place of residence arising from the business of the body.

The Remuneration Tribunal has determined that the rate of travelling allowance payable for overnight absences from the member's place of residence should be increased from \$49 to \$53.

The Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1980 maintains the relationship between the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 and determinations of the Remuneration Tribunal by increasing the rate of travelling allowance in accordance with the Tribunal's determination. The increase is effective from 1 July 1979.
