REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE (NO.2) 1980

No. 54 of 1980

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Remuneration Ordinance 1976 prescribes the rate of remuneration which is payable to a part-time member of certain prescribed A.C.T. statutory bodies in respect of his attendance at meetings, engagement on business and overnight absences from his place of residence arising from the business of the body.

The Remuneration Tribunal, in a determination that came into effect on 1 July 1980, recommended increases in various fees and allowances payable to part-time holders of statutory offices. The Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance (No.2) 1980 maintains the relationship between the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 and determinations of the Remuneration Tribunal, by increasing the fees and allowances payable to a chairman and member of a prescribed authority in accordance with the Tribunal's determination. The new rates are as follows:
