LAKES ORDINANCE 1976

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Lake Burley Griffin Ordinance 1965 presently provides for the administration, control and use of Lake Burley Griffin. The Lake Ginninderra (Temporary Control) Ordinance 1973 makes temporary provisions in relation to the control and use of Lake Ginninderra during the development of the lake.

The purpose of proposed Lakes Ordinance 1976 is to repeal both of these Ordinances and to provide for the administration, control and use of Lake Burley Griffin, Lake Ginninderra and other lakes which may be developed in the future.

The Legislative Assembly has agreed to the Ordinance.
