EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Construction Occupations (Licensing) Act 2004* is an Act to regulate construction occupations, and for other purposes.

Section 127 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2009 - 129 that set fees for the 2009-10 financial year and to determine fees for the 2010-11 financial year.

Special fees for Asbestos licences have been removed as they are no longer required. The additional occupation of Works Assessor has been included in the fee descriptions.

Fee increases are consistent with ACT Treasury's inflation factor of 3.5% (*2010/11 Budget Paper No 3.*). Appropriate rounding has occurred in relation to the increases.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2010.

The determination under section 127 of the Act is a disallowable instrument.
