EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Explanatory Notes

The *University of Canberra (Election of Staff, Student and Professorial Members of Academic Board) Statute 2010* regulates the election of the staff, student and professorial members of the Academic Board of the University. The statute and accompanying rules replace provisions in the *Academic Board Statute 1990* relating to elections. The *Academic Board Statute 1990* has been amended by a separate amending statute.

The *University of Canberra (Election of Staff, Student and Professorial Members of Academic Board) Statute 2010* provides the authorisation to make rules relating to the election of staff, student and professorial members of Academic Board. Details and mechanisms relating to the elections are included in a suite of three separate rules.

In making this Statute the University had regards to the provisions of section 40B(1)(b) of the *Human Rights Act 2004* (ACT).
