REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1982
14 of 1982
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1982 increases the fees payable to a part-time chairman and part-time member of a prescribed authority by approximately 20 per cent in accordance with the determination of the Remuneration Tribunal which came into effect on 1 July 1981.

The Ordinance also distinguishes between the amount of travelling allowance payable to a part-time chairman or part-time member of a prescribed authority according to whether or not the meeting attended by a chairman or member is in a capital city or elsewhere. The rate of allowance in the former case is \$70 and in the latter case \$56.

The increased rates have effect from 1 July 1981 in accordance with the Tribunal's determination. The legislative draftsman has advised that there is no legal impediment to an Ordinance being made retrospective.

Details of the Ordinance are set out below.

Section 1 cites the short title of the Ordinance as the Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1982.

Section 2 provides for the Ordinance to commence on 1 July 1981.

Section 3 cites the title of the Principal Ordinance as the Remuneration Ordinance 1976.

Sub-section 4(1) amends existing sub-section 3(8) by replacing it with a new sub-section providing amended rates of travelling allowance.

Sub-section 4(2) amends the Principal Ordinance by substituting where relevant new rates of sitting fees.
