AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Motor Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 4) 1977 and the Amendments of the Motor Traffic Regulations amend the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936 and Regulations to provide for increases in fees and charges.

The Ordinance restructures the fee for renewal of registration for motor vehicles up to 2 tonnes by setting a flat fee of \$56. Fees for other categories have been increased and the structure simplified.

Driver licence fees and various miscellaneous fees have also been increased.

The Regulations restructure the fees for renewal of registrations for trailers by dividing all trailers into two broad categories:

- (a) caravans and special purpose trailers; and
- (b) other trailers.

The former distinction between commercial trailers and private trailers is removed but fees continue to depend primarily upon the mass of the trailer. Some other fees have also been increased.
