TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance 1978 amends the Traffic Ordinance 1937 to require pedestrians to obey traffic lights erected at the entrances and exits to boom gate parking areas.

The Ordinance also requires riders of animals and bicycles to obey traffic lights when they are upon the road and will update references to the Motor Traffic Ordinance. Some metrication changes are included.
