CANBERRA RETAIL MARKETS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

Explanatory Memorandum

The Canberra Retail Markets (Amendment) Ordinance 1978 amends the Canberra Retail Markets Ordinance 1971:-

- to change the site of the Belconnen Retail Market from sections 8 and 9 and blocks 1 to 4, inclusive, of section 10 to block 2, section 31, Division of Belconnen, and
- to redefine the area surrounding the market within which hawkers are prohibited from carrying on business.

The site included in the definition was intended as the permanent site for the market. A temporary market is at present operating on an adjoining site. Experience in the operation of the temporary market has indicated to the National Capital Development Commission and the Canberra Retail Markets Trust that a site other than that specified in the Ordinance would be a more suitable location.
