REMUNERATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

NO. 21 OF 1978

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Remuneration Ordinance 1976 prescribes the amounts which are payable to part-time members of certain A.C.T. statutory bodies in respect of their attendance at meetings, engagement on business and overnight absences from their place of residence arising from a meeting or the business of the body. The rates presently prescribed are at the level which was determined by the Remuneration Tribunal for part-time office holders in 1976.

The Remuneration Tribunal has determined that the rate of travelling allowance payable for overnight absences from the member's place of residence should be increased from \$41 to \$45.

The Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1978 will maintain the relationship between the Remuneration Ordinance 1976 and determinations of the Remuneration Tribunal by increasing the rate of travelling allowances from \$41 to \$45.
