EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY

ORDINANCES REVISION (HEALTH COMMISSION) ORDINANCE 1975

The Capital Territory Health Commission, established by the Health Commission Ordinance 1975, is now responsible for health services in the Territory. It is to provide and conduct hospitals, nursing homes and other health institutions as well as offer a complete and co-ordinated health care system for the community.

2. With the establishment of the Commission, consequential amendments to transfer administration from the Department of Health to the Commission are required to several A.C.T. Ordinances and the Ordinances Revision (Health Commission) Ordinance 1975 will make those amendments.
