Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Parking Authority Declaration 2010 (No 4)

Disallowable Instrument DI2010–289

made under the

***Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000, section 75A (2)
(Parking Authorities)***

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Section 75A (2) of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2000* permits the Road Transport Authority (RTA) to declare a person to be a parking authority which may establish and operate a ticket parking scheme for any length of road or area under its control in accordance with the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Guidelines 2002*.

Perin Property Group Pty Ltd has applied to the RTA to be declared as a parking authority to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme within the boundaries of Block 2, Section 32 and Block 2 Section 31 in the suburb of Dickson.

The disallowable instrument effects the declaration by the RTA of Perin Property Group Pty Ltd as a Parking Authority to establish and operate a ticket parking scheme within the boundaries of Block 2, Section 32 and Block 2 Section 31 in the suburb of Dickson.

This declaration is a Disallowable Instrument, and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification in pursuance of Section 64 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
