ARCHITECTS ORDINANCE 1974

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The proposed Architects Ordinance 1974 will amend the Architects Ordinance 1959-1973 to increase the registration fee and to provide for the issuing of annual practising certificates.

Section 3 will increase the fee payable for a registration certificate from six dollars thirty cents to ten dollars as from 1 March 1974.

The proposed new section 18A will provide for the issue of an annual practising certificate upon payment by a registered architect of a fee of ten dollars. The effect of the proposed new section 30 will be to restrict the practice of architecture (other than landscape, naval or golf course architecture) to architects holding a practising certificate.

The other amendments are of a purely consequential nature.
