LIQUOR ORDINANCE 1971

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 6 of 1971

Since 1962 the buildings occupied by the Australian National University have been exempted from the provisions of the Liquor Ordinance relating to the sale of liquor.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to give similar exemptions to buildings occupied by residential colleges affiliated with the University and to buildings occupied by the Canberra College of Advanced Education.

The exemptions will apply only in respect of buildings in which the sale of liquor is authorised by a Statute of the University or College.
