LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ORDINANCE 1971
EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Section 71 of the Legal Practitioners Ordinances 1970 imposes an obligation on solicitors to deposit a certain proportion of their trust moneys with the Inspector of Solicitors' Trust Accounts. The date by which the first deposits are to be made is 14 March 1971.

The purpose of the amending Ordinance is to postpone the obligation, by substituting a provision that requires moneys to be deposited within one month after a date fixed by the Attorney-General.
