Public Place Names (Franklin) Amendment Determination 2011 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2011-43

made under the

Public Place Names Act 1989 — section 3 (Minister to determine names)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Public Place Names Act 1989* provides for the naming of divisions and public places and, in particular, section 3 empowers the Minister to determine in writing, notified in the ACT Legislation Register, the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 254A of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the Minister has delegated the power under the *Public Place Names Act 1989* to name a division or public place to the Chief Planning Executive, ACT Planning and Land Authority.

Section 46 of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that power given under an Act to make an instrument includes the power to amend or repeal the instrument.

This instrument AMENDS DI2006-215 by revoking one name in the Division of Franklin (Clare Burton Circuit) as specified in the attached Schedule A; and

DETERMINES the names of three roads in the Division of Franklin as specified in the attached Schedule B and associated plan. The theme for the naming of public places in Franklin is *writers, particularly women*.

The original road configuration notified in DI2006-215 has changed requiring an amendment to the road name. The road is now determined in this instrument as Clare Burton Crescent.

The number of women and men after whom divisions or public places have been named in the last 10 years, and whether the names of women are well represented, have been considered as required by the *Public Place Names Act 1989*.

This instrument commemorates three women.
