ADMINISTRATION AND PROBATE ORDINANCE (NO. 2) 1967

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 23 of 1967

Section 13 of the Administration and Probate Ordinance 1967 provides that certain of the amendments made by that Ordinance (the provisions relating to intestate succession) shall apply to the estates of persons dying after the commencement of that Ordinance. Different parts of the Ordinance come into operation on different dates. The object of this Ordinance is to clarify the dates on which the various parts come into operation.
