EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Government Procurement Act 2001 (the Act) provides for the creation of the Government Procurement Board (the Board), with the responsibility for reviewing and giving advice on procurement issues and procurement proposals and activities undertaken by territory entities in accordance with the Government Procurement Regulation 2007.

Section 12 of the Act enables the minister to appoint members and prescribes that a non-public employee member must not be a public employee.

Section 13 of the Act prescribes that a member must be appointed for a term of not longer than five years.

The minister has appointed Mr Bob Samarcq as a non-public employee member of the Government Procurement Board from the day after notification until 30 April 2013.

As the appointee is not a public servant and this instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act* 2001, Division 19.3.3 applies, under the *Legislation Act* 2001, s.229 the instrument is a disallowable instrument.

This appointment has been approved by the Minister for Territory and Municipal Services, and the Standing Committee on Public Accounts has been consulted in accordance with section 228 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.
