STANDARD TIME ORDINANCE 1965

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 11 of 1965

Sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Standard Time Ordinance 1938-1938 provides as follows:—

“The mean time of the one hundred and fiftieth meridian of longitude of Greenwich in England shall be deemed and is hereby declared to be standard time throughout the Territory.”

The expression “longitude of Greenwich”, should read “longitude east of Greenwich”. The Standard Time Ordinance 1965 will correct this drafting error.
