EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The purpose of the *Architects Act 2004* relates to the provision of architectural services and other purposes.

Section 91 of the Act provides the Minister with the power to determine fees.

The purpose of this determination is to revoke Disallowable Instrument DI 2010-120, which set fees for the 2010-11 financial year and to determine fees for the 2011-12 financial year.

The fees determined for the 2011-12 financial year have been determined with reference to the suite of occupational licensing fees charged across the construction and related industries. Fees are now being set consistently across a variety of occupations ensuring comparable fees are charged for comparable levels of regulatory activity.

The fees take effect on 1 July 2011.

The determination under Section 91 of the Act is a Disallowable Instrument.
