LIQUOR POLL ORDINANCE 1955

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

No. 8 of 1955

This Ordinance provides for the taking of a poll of the electors to decide which of three suggested periods of trading should be adopted for hotels in the A.C.T. and the Territory of Jervis Bay.

The three periods on which the electors will indicate their order of preference are – 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., 10 a.m. to 10 p.m., and 11.30 a.m. to 2.30 p.m. and 4 p.m. to 10 p.m.

The Ordinance provides for the taking of the poll on 17th September, 1955, the same day as that on which the elections for the A.C.T. Advisory Council will be held.
